MINUTES

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Finance was held on Thursday, June 17, 2010, at 11:34 a.m. in the Farnum Building, Room 110.

Senator Cassis gave opening remarks regarding the order of business:

- HB 6235 Rep. LeBlanc - Michigan business tax; credit; motorsport entertainment complexes; extend sunset.

Representative LeBlanc, bill sponsor of HB6235, gave verbal testimony explaining and in support of the bill. Representative LeBlanc then answered questions from committee members.

Alisha Cottrell and Dan DuBois representing the Michigan International Speedway gave verbal testimony in support of HB6235. Ms. Cottrell and Mr. DuBois then answered questions from committee members.

Scott Schragger representing the Department of Treasury submitted a testimony card neutral to HB6235 but did not wish to speak; however, Mr. Schragger was called upon to answer questions from committee members.

Senator Jansen motioned, and Senator Jacobs seconded, that the committee report HB6235 with favorable recommendation and immediate effect.
