SENATE COMMITTEE ON REFORMS AND RESTRUCTURING

Minutes for April 27, 2010

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Reforms and Restructuring was held on Tuesday, April 27, 2010, in the Senate Hearing Room of the Boji Tower. Senator Bishop called the meeting to order at 2:47 p.m.

Attendance was recorded as follows:

Present: Senators Bishop, Gilbert, George, Kuipers, Prusi, Hunter and Cherry

Absent: None

The Agenda Summary is as follows:

SB 1075 - Sen. Bishop

The Chair began by taking roll and asking members to approve the committee minutes from April 13, 2010. A motion was offered by Senator Kuipers, support given by Senator Gilbert, and the members approved the committee minutes by a vote of 7 to 0 as follows:

Approval of the minutes from the 4-20-10 meeting:

Yeas: Senators Bishop, Gilbert, George, Kuipers, Prusi, Cherry and Hunter

Nays: None

The Chair then turned the members' attention to the bill on the day's agenda, Senate Bill 1075 sponsored by Senator Bishop.

The Chair then asked Jamie Clover Adams to explain the changes in the substitute for SB 1075.

Discussion and questions followed.

The Chair then read the card of those not wishing to testify:

➤ Rebecca Park representing Michigan Farm Bureau supports SB 1075.

As there was a substitute being offered, Senator Gilbert then made a motion for the purpose of discussion to adopt the (S-1) substitute on Senate Bill 1075. Support was offered by Senator George and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 3 as follows:

Adopt the (S-1) version of Senate Bill 1075:

Yeas: Senators Bishop, Gilbert, George, and Kuipers

Nays: Senators Prusi, Hunter and Cherry

Discussion and questions followed.

Being no further testimony, Senator Gilbert then followed with a motion, for the purpose of discussion to report the (S-1) substitute on Senate Bill 1075 with favorable recommendation and immediate effect. Support was offered by Senator Kuipers and the motion passed by a vote of 4 to 3 as follows:
