A meeting of the Senate Families, Seniors, and Human Services Committee was held on Wednesday, November 9, 2011, at 3:00 p.m. in the Farnum Building, Room 210.

Attendance was recorded as follows:

Senator Emmons announced the order of business:

- SB 711 Sen. Moolenaar - Gaming; lottery; lottery winners; require lottery bureau to share names with certain other state agencies.
- SB 712 Sen. Green - Human services; services or financial assistance; eligibility for public assistance; prohibit for certain lottery winners.

Senator Emmons announced an agenda change that SB711 and SB712 have been postponed for the day.

Senator Emmons announced other business properly before the committee HB5114.

- HB5114 Rep. Horn - Human services; employment and training; sunset on certain exemptions and sanctions; remove.

Senator Gregory motioned to adopt the minutes of October 26, 2011 and October 27, 2011.
