**Senate Committee on Outdoor Recreation and Tourism**

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Outdoor Recreation and Tourism was held on Thursday, October 6, 2011 at 12:30 p.m. in Room 210 of the Farnum Building.

The meeting was called to order at 2:34 p.m.

Senator Hansen called the meeting to order.

Senator Hansen announced the order of business for the day:

Approval of Minutes

SB 412 Sen. Booher Natural resources; hunting; wild turkey license fee; modify use.

Senator Brandenburg moved to adopt the minutes from September 22, 2011 with unanimous consent. Without objection, the minutes were adopted.

Senator Hansen placed before the committee Senate Bill 412 (Sen. Booher). Senator Booher and Kara Butters, legislative director for Senator Booher, testified in explanation of the bill and substitute, and answered questions from committee members.
