A meeting of the Senate Committee on Outdoor Recreation and Tourism was held on Thursday, October 20, 2011 at 12:30 p.m. in Room 210 of the Farnum Building.

The meeting was called to order at 12:33 p.m.

Senator Hansen called the meeting to order.

Senator Hansen announced the order of business for the day:

Approval of Minutes

SB 685 Sen. Proos Natural resources; hunting; issuance of deer damage shooting permits; limit number of authorized shooters.

SB 717 Sen. Proos Natural resources; hunting; hunters helping farmers program; create.
