COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

October 12, 2011

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Reforms, Restructuring and Reinventing was held on Wednesday, October 12, 2011, in rooms 402 and 403 of the Capitol Building at 8:30 a.m. Senator Jansen called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

The agenda summary is as follows:

1) Discussion on a proposal to allow the Governor to appoint up to 1% of all the employees of each state department to allow for the executive branch to have more direct oversight of the departments.
