MINUTES

A meeting of the Senate Families, Seniors, and Human Services Committee was held on Wednesday, November 30, 2011, at 3:01 p.m. in the Farnum Building, Room 210.

Senator Emmons announced the order of business:

(Testimony Only)

- SB 711 Sen. Moolenaar - Gaming; lottery; lottery winners; require lottery bureau to share names with certain other state agencies.
- SB 712 Sen. Green - Human services; services or financial assistance; eligibility for public assistance; prohibit for certain lottery winners.

Senator Gregory motioned, supported by Senator Rocca, to adopt the minutes of November 9, 2011.

Without objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous voice.

Senator Moolenaar, bill sponsor of SB711, gave verbal testimony explaining both SB711 and SB712. Senator Moolenaar then answered questions from committee members.

Senator Emmons gave verbal testimony explaining the Senate Substitute S-1 to SB712.

Karyn Ferrick, representing the Department of Human Services gave verbal testimony in support of SB712. Ms. Ferrick then answered questions from committee members.

Andi Brancato, representing the Michigan Lottery, gave verbal testimony to provide clarification to the committee members. Mr. Brancato then answered questions from committee members.

Being no further business before the Committee, Senator Emmons adjourned the meeting without objection at 3:24 p.m.
