MINUTES

A meeting of the Senate Economic Development Committee was held on Wednesday, February 22, 2012, at 1:30 p.m. in the Farnum Building, Room 110.

Senator Kowall called the meeting to order at 1:34 p.m.

Attendance was recorded as follows:

Senator Kowall announced the order of business:

- HB 5332 (Rep. Haveman)--Income tax; returns; mandatory unitary filing for certain taxpayers with a certificated credit; eliminate.—Testimony Only

Senator Emmons motioned, supported by Senator Nofs, that the committee adopt the minutes of February 8, 2012.

Without objection, the motion prevailed by unanimous voice.

Senator Kowall placed before the committee House Bill 5332 (Rep. Haveman). Representative Haveman explained the bill to committee members.

The following persons testified on House Bill 5332 and answered questions from the committee members:

- Dave DeGraaf, representing Johnson Controls—Support (also submitted written testimony on file with clerk)
- James McBryde, representing the Michigan Economic Development Corporation—Support

Senator Hansen motioned to report the bill out of committee. Senator Kowall noted the bill was noticed for testimony only and that the committee would take action on the bill at a subsequent committee meeting. Senator Hansen withdrew his motion.

Senator Nofs moved to excuse absent members. Without objection, absent members were excused.

Being no further business before the committee, Senator Kowall adjourned the meeting without objection at 1:45 p.m.
