Senate Committee on Judiciary

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Judiciary was held on Thursday, November 8, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. in Rooms 402/403 of the Capitol Building.

The meeting was called to order at 9:07 a.m.

Members present: Senators Jones, Rocca, Bieda
Members excused: Senator Schuitmaker

Senator Jones called the meeting to order.

Senator Jones announced the following agenda for the committee:

Approval of Minutes from October 17, 2012

SB 1315 Sen. Proos Criminal procedure; warrants; warrantless search of parolees; provide for.

SB 1321 Sen. Jones Occupations; security guards; reporting crimes to law enforcement; require.

Senator Bieda moved to adopt the minutes from October 17, 2012 with unanimous consent. Without objection, the minutes were adopted.

Senator Jones placed before the committee Senate Bill 1315 (Sen. Proos). Senator Proos explained the bill to committee members and answered questions.
