## COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES May 9, 2012

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Reforms, Restructuring and Reinventing was held on Wednesday, May 9, 2012, in rooms 402 and 403 of the Capitol at 8:30 a.m.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. He instructed the Clerk to call the roll. At that time, the following members were present; Chairman Jansen, Sen.(s) Colbeck, Casperson, Kowall, Young and Warren, a quorum.

The Chairman entertained a motion by Sen. Casperson to adopt the minutes of the May 2, 2012 committee meeting.

The motion prevailed.

The Chairman invited the Rep. Forlini to summarize HB 5158 for the committee.

Sen. Young made a motion to adopt his amendment, amendment #1 to the (S-2) version of HB 5158.

Pass: Sen. Kowall

The motion failed.
