MINUTES

The Senate Committee on Transportation held a meeting on Tuesday, February 7, 2012, at 12:30 p.m. in Room 100 of the Farnum Building. Senator Casperson called the meeting to order at 12:43 p.m.

Senator Casperson announced the following order of business:

- Adoption of January 31, 2012, minutes
- HB 4978 Rep. Daley Vehicles; registration plates; distribution of funds collected for the organ and tissue donation education fund; modify.

Senator Casperson led the members in the Pledge of Allegiance.

Senator Casperson requested a motion to adopt the minutes of the January 31, 2012, committee meeting. Senator Kowall offered the motion; being no objection, the motion prevailed.
