Dear Senator Rocca:

I am writing to you to request you to vote NO on House Bill 4561. This bill would result in Michigan no longer having the most up-to-date building codes – codes that ensure safety, hold down the cost of home ownership (including insurance costs) and help reduce damage to homes during bad weather. The bill also will delay introduction of important new technologies in the Michigan construction market, reducing choices and innovation for building owners and hurting manufacturers of those technologies, many of whom are located in Michigan.
