MINUTES

The Senate Committee on Education held a meeting on Wednesday, October 23, 2013 at 12:00 p.m. in the Senate Hearing Room, Ground Floor, Boji Tower.

Senator Pavlov called the meeting to order at 12:08 p.m.

Senator Pavlov announced the order of business for the Education Committee:

- Adoption of the minutes from the October 16, 2013 meeting
- SB 442 Sen Marleau Education; school districts; requirement for levy of taxes to collect judgment against a school district; modify in revised school code.
- SB 443 Sen. Marleau Civil procedure; other; collection of judgment against a school district; limit.

Senator Pavlov announced the next order of business would be Senate Bills 442-443. Senator Marleau gave members a brief overview of changes being considered for the legislation.
