Senate Committee on Judiciary
Minutes

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Judiciary was held on Tuesday, February 19, 2013 at 2:30 p.m. in Room 110 of the Farnum Building.

The meeting was called to order at 2:30 p.m.

Members present: Senators Jones, Schuitmaker, Rocca, and Bieda

Senator Jones called the meeting to order and announced the order of business for the meeting:

Adopt Minutes

SB 162 Sen. Nofs Courts; jurisdiction; jurisdiction for prosecution of felony offenses;
expand to include county where consequence intended to have effect.

Senator Jones moved to adopt the minutes from February 12, 2013 with unanimous consent. Without objection, the minutes were adopted.

Senator Jones placed before the committee Senate Bill 162 (Sen. Nofs). Senator Nofs explained the bill to committee members and answered questions.

Senator Bieda moved to adopt the Jones Amendment #1 to Senate Bill 162. The motion prevailed by an affirmative vote of a majority of the members appointed to and serving on the committee, voting as follows:
