A meeting of the Senate Committee on Judiciary was held on Tuesday, September 24, 2013, at 2:30 p.m. in Room 110 of the Farnum Building.

Senator Jones called the meeting to order and announced the order of business for the meeting:

SB 471    Sen. Kahn            Criminal procedure; records; dissemination of juvenile criminal history record information; prohibit under certain circumstances.

Senator Schuitmaker moved to adopt the minutes from September 17, 2013 with unanimous consent. Without objection, the minutes were adopted.

Senator Jones placed before the committee SB 471 and the S-1 Substitute. He then called Senator Kahn, accompanied by Chris Hawkins of the Michigan State Police, forward to explain the legislation and answer questions for committee members.
