Senate Committee on Outdoor Recreation and Tourism
Minutes

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Outdoor Recreation and Tourism was held on Thursday, October 24, 2013 at 12:30 p.m. in Room 110 of the Farnum Building.

The meeting was called to order at 1:27 p.m.

Members present: Senators Hansen, Hildenbrand, Casperson, Moolenaar, Young, Hopgood
Members excused: Senator Meekhof

Senator Hansen called the meeting to order.

Senator Hansen announced the order of business for the day:

- Approval of the Minutes
- SB 68 (Sen. Hansen) – Vehicles; off-road; definition of ATV; revise to create separate category of recreational off-road vehicles.

Senator Hildenbrand moved to adopt the committee minutes from October 10, 2013 by unanimous consent. Without any objection, the minutes were adopted.

Senator Hansen moved to excuse absent members. Without objection, absent members were excused.

Senator Hansen placed before the committee Senate Bill 68 as well as an S-2 Substitute. Senator Hansen explained the bill and answered questions for committee members.

Senator Young moved that the S-2 substitute be adopted to Senate Bill 68. The motion prevailed by an affirmative vote of the majority of the members appointed to and serving on the committee, voting as follows:
