## COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES March 20, 2014

A joint committee meeting of the Senate Insurance Committee and the House Insurance Committee was held on Thursday, March 20, 2014, at 9:30 a.m. in the Farnum Building, Room 110.

#### The agenda summary is as follows:

1. Reported SB 715 (S-1) with recommendation and immediate effect.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:32 a.m. He instructed the Clerk to call the roll.

Attendance was recorded as follows:

Present: Senator(s) Hune (C), Marleau, Brandenburg, Hansen, Robertson and Bieda.

Absent: Senator Smith

A quorum was established.

The Chairman entertained a motion to excuse absent members. Sen. Robertson so moved, and without objection, absent members were excused.

The Chairman entertained a motion to adopt the committee meeting minutes from the March 4, 2014 meeting. Sen. Marleau so moved, and without objection, the minutes were adopted.

The Chairman invited Kendra Everett, representing Sen. Casperson's office, and Scott Hummel, representing MAIA, to explain the changes made to SB 715 in the substitute (S-1). They are in support of the bill.
