A meeting of the Senate Committee on Reforms, Restructuring and Reinventing was held on Wednesday, September 24, 2014 in Rooms 402 and 403 of the Capitol Building, at 9:00 a.m.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:01 a.m. He instructed the Clerk to call the roll. Attendance was recorded as follows:
