COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES May 15, 2014

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Regulatory Reform was scheduled for Thursday, May 15, 2014, at 1:00 p.m., in room 210 of the Farnum Building.

The agenda summary is as follows:

- 1) Reported HB 4684 (S-1) with recommendation and immediate effect.
- 2) Reported HB 5220 with recommendation and immediate effect.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 2:25 p.m. He instructed the Clerk to call the roll. The following members were present; Chairman Rocca, Sen.(s) Hune, Pavlov and Warren, a quorum.

The Chairman entertained a motion from Sen. Hune to adopt the minutes of the May 8, 2014, committee meeting. Without objection, the minutes were adopted.
