DRAFT COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES September 18, 2014

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Regulatory Reform was scheduled for Thursday, September 18, 2014, at 1:00 p.m., in room 210 of the Farnum Building.

The agenda summary is as follows:

- 1) Reported HB 4890 (S-2) with recommendation and immediate effect.
- 2) Heard testimony regarding SB 986 - 986.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m. He instructed the Clerk to call the roll. The following members were present; Chairman Rocca, Sen.(s) Jones, Hune, Meekhof, Pavlov and Warren, a quorum.
