COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
October 14, 2015

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Appropriations was scheduled for Wednesday, October 14, 2015, at 2:00 p.m., in the Senate Appropriations Room of the Capitol Building.

The agenda summary is as follows:

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m. He instructed the Clerk to call the roll.
