A meeting of the Senate Committee on Transportation was scheduled for Wednesday, July 1st 2015, at 8:00 a.m., in 110 Farnum Building.

The agenda summary is as follows:

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 8:03 a.m. He instructed the Clerk to call the roll. At that time, the following members were present: Chairman Casperson, Sen(s). Horn, Pavlov, and Marleau, a quorum.
