## COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES January 21, 2016

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Economic Development and International Investment was scheduled for Thursday, January 21, 2016, at 1:30 p.m., in room 210 of the Farnum Building, 125 W. Allegan Street, Lansing, MI 48933.

#### The agenda summary is as follows:

1. Reported SB 673 (Sen. Horn) with recommendation and immediate effect.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 1:34 p.m. He instructed the Clerk to call the roll.

Attendance for the meeting was recorded as follows:

A quorum was present. Sen. Schmidt was not present at the time the roll was called.

The Chairman entertained a motion from Sen. Stamas to adopt the committee meeting minutes of November 2, 2015 joint meeting with the Committee on Transportation and the Committee on Commerce. Without objection, the minutes were adopted.

The Chairman gave an overview of SB 673. He then invited Rep. Brunner and Sara Dimitroff of the City of Bay City to provide a more detailed overview of the legislation.
