MINUTES

March 22, 2016

The Senate Education Committee held a meeting on Tuesday, March 22, 2016 at 12:00 p.m., in Room 110 of the Farnum Building.

The agenda summary is as follows:

1. HB 4822 – S-6 reported with recommendation and recommended immediate effect

The Chair called the meeting to order at 2:21 p.m.

Senator Colbeck made a motion to adopt the minutes from the March 22, 2016, 8:30 a.m. meeting; being no objection, the minutes were adopted.
