April 25, 2016**

A meeting of the Joint Select Committee on the Flint Water Public Health Emergency was scheduled for Tuesday, April 25, 2016, at 9:00 a.m., in the Senate Hearing Room of the Boji Tower.

The agenda summary is as follows:

1. A discussion with Department of Environmental Quality Director Keith Creagh and Department of Health and Human Services Director Nick Lyon regarding the Flint water public health emergency.
 2. A discussion with Governor Snyder's new Cabinet Director Mike Zimmer and Captain Chris Kelenske, deputy state director of Emergency Management and Homeland Security within the State Police, regarding the efforts in Flint, Michigan.
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The Chairman called the meeting to order at 9:05 a.m. He instructed the Clerk to call the roll. At that time, the following members were present; Chairman Stamas, Rep. McBroom, Sen. Hune, Rep. Canfield, Sen. Ananich and Rep. Irwin.
