June 9, 2016

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Oversight was scheduled for Thursday, June 9, 2016 at 8:30 a.m., in the 100 Room of the Farnum Building.

1. Reported SB 962 (S-1) (Sen. Stamas) with recommendation and immediate effect.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 8:31 a.m. He instructed the Clerk to call the roll. At that time, the following members were present: Chairman MacGregor, Sen.(s) Kowall and Stamas, a quorum was present.

The Chairman entertained a motion by Sen. Stamas to adopt the meeting minutes from February 11, 2016. Without objection, the minutes were adopted.
