- Common Core-- the Federal take-over of education. Illegal.

It has not been studied, and there are no benchmarks for it. The Gates' foundation supplies all computer resources.

- Another damage attributed to CC is changing the content material in the various subject matters. Example: Dr. David Coleman is responsible for the history curriculum. He's coined the phrase "white privilege," and has asked questions like, "Was the Holocaust a hoax?" of students. He's singlehandedly rewriting history with lies.
- CC emphasizes non-fiction technological manuals, gov't documents, and even menus in place of classic literature by renowned authors.
- The "Qatar Connection" and its influence in American education has a link to the White House. Our US Department of Defense, Dept. of State, and Dept. of Ed. have partnered with "Connect All Schools," whose aim is the spread of Islam worldwide, to link classrooms in the US and internationally.
