RESOLUTION 2015-25

SUPPORT FOR THE SECTION OF US HIGHWAY 2 TO BE NAMED AS THE KENNETH J. MORASKA MEMORIAL HIGHWAY

At the regular scheduled Council Meeting of November 2, 2015, held in the Curtis J. Brackett Council Chambers at City Hall, Norway, Michigan 49870 commencing at 7 p.m.

Naming the portion of US Highway 2 that goes through the City of Norway in Dickinson County as the "Kenneth J. Moraska Memorial Highway"

WHEREAS, Ken Moraska of Norway, Michigan was born on May 11, 1945 and died at the age of 26 on May 26, 1971 in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, Officer Moraska gave his life and died by gunfire while responding to a domestic disturbance and is the only officer of Norway's police force to have been killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Norway commemorates Officer Moraska, his life, and his death and wishes to memorialize the life and sacrifice of Officer Moraska; and

WHEREAS, US-2 travels through Norway in Dickinson County, Michigan, and


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Norway endorses the proposal of naming the US 2 Highway going through Norway City "KENNETH J. MORASKA MEMORIAL HIGHWAY", and



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the costs for the fabrication and installation of signs for this naming will be handled through local funding.
