COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES
November 30, 2016

A meeting of the Senate Committee on Outdoor Recreation and Tourism was scheduled for Wednesday, November 30, 2016, at 1:00 p.m., in the 110 Room of the Farnum Building.

The agenda summary is as follows:

1. Reported HB 5484 (S-1) (Rep. Lyons) with recommendation and immediate effect.

The Chairman called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m. He instructed the Clerk to call the roll. At that time, the following members were present; Chairman Hansen, Sen.(s) Zorn, and Schmidt, a quorum was present.
