

Senators of the Energy and Technology Committee,

I am requesting that SB 637 be put on hold so that you may have the opportunity to study the health implications of passing this Bill as written. Wireless radiation has been proven thousands of times by peer reviewed, independent science to increase cancer rates, have neurological effects, immune system disorders, and reproductive harm.

The U.S. Army uses 95GHz as a biological weapon, named the Active denial System. The small cells for 5G wireless uses high frequency radiation between 24GHz to 90 GHz.
