A meeting of the Senate Committee on Judiciary and Public Safety was scheduled for Thursday, January 24, 2019, at 8:30 a.m., in the 1300 Room of the Binsfeld Building.

The agenda summary is as follows:

2. Reported SB 2 (Sen. Lucido) with recommendation and immediate effect.
