FINAL PASSAGE

[SB 95](#) (Jelinek)

SB 95 would provide a template or "place holder" for a potential supplemental multidepartment appropriation for Fiscal Year 2008-2009.

- Substitute H-1 was adopted.
- Agema-1A was not adopted.
- SB 95 was advanced to 3rd reading.
- SB 95 was passed [RC 446: 107 yes, 0 no]
- IE was ordered.

[HB 5207](#) (Robert Jones)

HB 5207 would repeal the reversion clause to certain state land deeded to Western Michigan University in 1978.

- Substitute H-1 was not adopted
- Jones-2 was adopted.
- HB 5207 was advanced to 3rd reading.
- HB 5207 was passed [RC 448: 105 yes, 2 no]
- IE was ordered.

[SB 164](#) (Barcia)

SB 164 would authorize issuance of crossbow hunting permits to individuals with temporary disabilities.

- SB 164 was advanced to 3rd reading.
- SB 164 was passed [RC 447: 107 yes, 0 no]

SB 253 **(Garcia)**

SB 253 would provide a “template” or “place holder” for the Fiscal Year 2009-2010 State Police budget. This bill contains no appropriations, but may be amended at a later date to include them.

- Leblanc H-7 was adopted.
- Moss 1-A was not adopted.
- Genetski 1-B was not adopted.
- Agema 1-C was not adopted.
- Gregory 1-D was adopted.
- Byrum 1-E was not adopted.
- SB 253 was advanced to 3rd reading.
- SB 253 was passed [RC 449: 68 yes, 39 no]
- IE was ordered.
