FINAL PASSAGE

HB 4205 (Pearce)

HB 4205 would explicitly prohibit recklessly placing an obstruction in a roadway, with penalties ranging from a \$100 fine to up to 15 years in prison depending on whether anyone is injured or killed, or any material damage is caused.

- Byrnes-1 adopted
- HB 4205 advanced to 3rd reading
- HB 4205 was passed [RC 262: 102 yes, 1 no]
- IE was ordered

SB 108 (Kahn)

SB 108 would define a veterans organization allowed to hold charitable gambling events as including an auxiliary of a national veterans organization chartered Congress.

- SB 108 advanced to 3rd reading
- SB108 was passed [RC 263: 104 yes, 0 no]
