## MESSAGES FROM THE SENATE

### [HB 5122](#)

(Kandrevas)

HB 5122 would exempt service club and religious sign structures less than eight square feet in area from regulations and restrictions on highway billboards. The bill also bans animated signs, unless the signs change below a certain speed and have limited luminescence, revises renewal fees and penalties for late renewal, places caps on the aggregate revenue collected from these, and revises regulations on cutting down vegetation blocking signs.

## FINAL PASSAGE

### [HB 4311](#)

(Cushingberry)

Appropriations; zero budget; supplemental appropriations; provide for fiscal year 2008-2009.

- Substitute H-3 was adopted
- Proos 1-A was not adopted
- HB 4311 was advanced to 3<sup>rd</sup> reading
- HB 4311 was passed [RC 403: 62 yes, 45 no]
- IE was ordered

### [HB 4410](#)

(Sheltrown)

HB 4410 would authorize an alternative public high school “general diploma” with reduced curriculum requirements from those required under a [2006 law](#) establishing minimum statewide

standards, and authorize up to 15 high school “specialty schools” with even lower requirements, subject to certain additional performance standards.

- Substitute H-3 was adopted
- Sheltroun 1-A was adopted
- Melton 1-B was adopted
- Sheltroun 1-C was adopted
- HB 4410 was advanced to 3<sup>rd</sup> reading
- HB 4410 was passed [RC 404: 97 yes, 10 no]
- IE was ordered

### **HB 5275**

**(Lisa Brown)**

HB 5275 would authorize a four-year, \$100 million subsidy for a manufacturer of “large scale power systems designed to convert variable renewable power into firm dispatchable power”.

- Mcmillin-1 was not adopted
- Mcmillin-2 was not adopted
- Mcmillin-3 was not adopted
- HB 5275 was advanced to 3<sup>rd</sup> reading
- HB 5275 was passed [RC 402: 90 yes, 17 no]
- IE was ordered
