HB 4191 would authorize an income tax deduction for charitable contributions by an individual to the state advance tuition payment fund, which is a program that provides for pre-payment of a particular child's future tuition at state universities. The tax deductions the bill would authorize are not for contributions a particular student, but into a general tuition subsidy pool.
