School Aid continuation budget.

- Jelinek-1 adopted [RC 505: 21 yes, 15 no, 1 not voting]
- Substitute H-2 concurred in as amended [RC 506: 21 yes, 15 no, 1 not voting]
- IE was not ordered [RC 507: 21 yes, 15 no, 1 not voting]

SB 831**(Jelinek)**

Continuation departmental budget.

- IE was ordered
- Motion to reconsider IE and pass temporarily
- Motion withdrawn

SB 243**(Jansen)**

Department of Labor, Energy, and Economic Growth appropriations for fiscal year 2009-2010.

- IE was granted
- Motion to reconsider IE and pass temporarily

SB 248**(Hardiman)**

Department of Human Services appropriations for fiscal year 2009-2010.

- IE was ordered
- Motion to reconsider IE and pass temporarily

SB 785**(Birkholz)**

Senate Bill 785 (H-4) and HB 5463 (H-4) would amend Wetlands Protection Act to make requirements more consistent with federal requirements and streamline the permitting process for activities that are likely to have minimal adverse affects on aquatic resources and for activities within areas of both state and federal jurisdiction.

- The Senate concurred with the House substitute H-4 [RC 508: 34 yes, 0 no, 3 excused]
