RE: Estimates of School District Funding from the Federal Stimulus Package

On February 26, 2009, the Senate Fiscal Agency (SFA) published estimates of the amounts of certain Federal funds that could be allocated to individual school districts as a result of the enactment of the Federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA). The four categories of funding estimated were Title I, Special Education, Education Incentive grants, and virtually unrestricted Stabilization Funds. The report can be found at:

According to a number of recent published reports, it appears that there is a perception that the SFA estimates of these stimulus funds that will go to schools are being viewed as final allocations, rather than estimates. While the SFA analysis indicated an estimated amount for each school using a specific set of assumptions (outlined on the second page of the report), there are a number of factors that could significantly affect the estimates.

Specifically, the Title I and Special Education figures are accurate on a statewide basis, though school district allocations will differ, once complete formula data are available. The estimates for the Education Incentive grants used an assumption that the State would be awarded a competitive grant based on population, and half of that grant amount would be distributed to districts (per the ARRA). Therefore, these grants are true estimates, and there are no recent data or indications to change these numbers at this time, but they may change in the future.

Turning to the stabilization funds, the estimates for these grants to school districts could change substantially from the figures shown on the analysis. Since the time of the original report, there are three major factors, discussed below, which could reduce the estimates of the stabilization funds for schools, which totaled more than \$1.1 billion in the original analysis. Below are highlighted these three factors that could significantly reduce the estimates.

- **Declining State revenues.** The February 26, 2009, analysis only assumed the necessity of restoring the Governor's proposed K-12 foundation allowance cuts (about \$113.0 million) and the 3% cuts to universities (about \$81.0 million), which used the January revenue estimates as the base. As has been reported, January and February actual revenue collections were about \$200.0 million below the amount forecasted just two months ago. If this trend continues, more of the stabilization funds are likely to be required simply to shore up existing State funding levels, both in the current year and in fiscal year 2010. In addition, depending on the State's revenue situation, the State may need to set aside a portion of the stabilization funds in order to maintain guaranteed funding levels in fiscal year 2011. Each dollar used in this manner means a direct reduction in the amount of stabilization funds estimated to go out to school districts.

- **Higher Education Funding Guarantee.** The SFA analysis assumed that only \$81.0 million would be required to meet the funding guarantee for higher education, such that funding for universities and community colleges in fiscal years 2010 and 2011 couldn't be below the current-year level. However, there has been some discussion of an interpretation that universities and community colleges would receive their fiscal year 2008 (instead of 2009) funding levels, which were significantly higher due to the repayment of the August 2007 funding delay in fiscal year 2008. If this proposal is adopted, then \$506.0 million more would be paid to higher education, thereby reducing the stabilization fund estimates shown for school districts by 46%.
- **Other Funding Appropriated in Next Year's K-12 Budget.** Since the upcoming year's budget has not yet been enacted, the final appropriations will end up determining the net shortfall in State funding which will be "backfilled" with Federal stimulus dollars. If a budget is enacted which restores more than the \$113.0 million in foundation allowance cuts assumed in the SFA analysis, then each dollar spent on other K-12 initiatives will reduce the amount of stabilization funds flowing out to districts.

Therefore, given the unpredictability of the factors outlined above, schools in your Senate district should use caution when reviewing the estimated allocations of the specified Federal grants, particularly the estimates shown for the stabilization fund dollars. The numbers in the SFA report represent the maximum amount that could be received, if the assumptions originally used prove accurate. However, there is the potential for a "perfect storm" such that, given the continually changing economic and revenue climate, higher education funding potential, and final budget appropriations, the stabilization fund grants are virtually eliminated.

Estimated Grants for K-12 for Major Federal Stimulus Programs

Notes on Estimates of Federal Grants to K-12 School Districts – Revised February 26, 2009

- Due to a lack of data breaking out total Title I allocations into its four components (basic allocation, concentrated allocation, targeted allocation, and education finance incentive grant allocation), the Title I estimates shown in this document use total Title I allocations as the basis for distributing the \$10 billion in Federal Title I funds. Note: the \$10 billion is actually \$5 billion in targeted grants and the other \$5 billion is education finance incentive grants. Again, the estimates here use the total Title I allocation as the basis, but the final numbers will be based upon the amounts given to school districts for targeted grants and education finance incentive grants.
- The other \$3.0 billion that is appropriated nationally for Education for the Disadvantaged is for School Improvement Grants. According to the Michigan Department of Education's web site, Title I School Improvement grants are available to schools that receive Title I, Part A funds and are identified for improvement, corrective action or restructuring because they have failed to meet the state's adequate yearly progress targets for two or more consecutive years. These grants are used to pay the costs of external technical assistance and professional development for staff needed to support the school's improvement, corrective action or restructuring plan. The SFA did not estimate the amount of these grants going out to school districts, and the estimates shown on the following pages do not include this funding.
- Special Education funding was estimated by allocating the new dollars proportionately using the most recent IDEA allocation data available.
- The Education Finance Incentive Grant estimates were derived as follows: it was assumed that the State grant would be \$163.5 million, which represents Michigan's share of the nation's population. The grant itself is competitive, and it is entirely unknown what amount, if any, Michigan would receive. However, if the State received something approximating its per capita share, then that amount would be \$163.5 million out of the \$5.0 billion grant total. The Federal law says that at least 50% of the State grant amount must be passed along to school districts based on their Title I allocations. Therefore, the estimates to school districts on the following pages reflect the allocation of \$81.8 million (50% of the estimated grant).
- The stabilization fund estimates were derived as follows: it is estimated that the State will receive \$1.8 billion total in stabilization funding. Of this amount, it is estimated that the State will receive the \$163.5 million listed above for Education Finance Incentive grants, leaving about \$1.6 billion. From that amount, 81.8% must be allocated for K-12 and postsecondary, and the other 18.2% for relatively unrestricted State purposes. The 81.8% represents about \$1.3 billion, and the other \$300 million is virtually unrestricted general aid to the State. Of the \$1.3 billion, the Federal law says the first use of the funds is to restore cuts in K-12 to the primary elementary and secondary funding formula, and to restore cuts in postsecondary funding such that 2010 and 2011 levels are not below the higher of 2008 or 2009 levels. After such cuts are restored, the remainder of the stimulus money is distributed to K-12 schools based on their proportionate share of Title I funding. It is the interpretation of the SFA at this time (subject to change) that approximately \$200 million is needed to restore the cuts proposed by the Governor for 2010 (\$113 million to restore K-12 foundation allowance cuts and \$81 million to restore university cuts to 2009 levels), leaving \$1.1 billion that would be distributed out to school districts via Title I allocations. The printout reflects spreading this \$1.1 billion using the Title I allocations. However, it is certainly up for interpretation just what should be the base year and what will eventually be needed to guarantee funding levels as required under the Federal stimulus. There are nearly infinite possibilities for the postsecondary and K-12 budgets to be structured such that the amount of stabilization funds going out to school districts could be substantially less than the \$1.1 billion shown in this analysis, and thus caution should be exercised in using these estimates as the basis on which to build school budgets.

The notes above are intended to illustrate the methodology used to calculate the estimates of grants on the following pages. Clearly, there are many questions left to be answered, along with numerous estimates and interpretations of the Federal laws and how those laws will be implemented by the State. Another question would be how much stimulus money may be set aside to ensure that 2011 is funded appropriately, as well as backfilling any proposed tax increases that aren't adopted. Any amount set aside for these purposes would reduce the amount going to school districts.

Finally, the Stabilization Funding used the FY 2008-09 Title I allocations and distributed the total funding proportionately (per the Act).
