By proactively expanding system capacity, the City can accommodate residential growth without overburdening existing infrastructure, helping to maintain service reliability for current residents while enabling responsible growth that aligns with community plans. This request represents an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because it is a one-time, capital investment in publicly owned infrastructure that will serve multiple public purposes over decades. The improvements will support economic opportunities, enhance public safety, protect environmental quality, and position the community for sustainable growth, delivering lasting value to residents and the broader region.
