- Data Democratization: Development of accessible dashboards, interactive data tools, and publicly available reporting to support policymakers, service providers and community partners.
- Advanced Data Analytics: Implementation of predictive analytics, real-time monitoring tools and enhanced performance dashboards that support strategic resource allocation and improved outcomes.
- Cross-System Data Integration: Initiatives to strengthen alignment between HMIS and other state systems; including behavioral health, foster care and housing programs; to support coordinated care and reduce duplication.
- Capacity Building: Training and technical support for CoCs

and provider agencies to increase analytic capability and improve local use of data in planning and service delivery.
