Altarum provides an electronic e-consent tool for MDHHS allowing healthcare providers to quickly understand the types of sensitive patient information they can share under state and federal laws. To coordinate care across physical and behavioral health (BH) services, patients and providers require timely access to shared patient information. Altarum's proprietary tool is housed on the MDHHS website and helps providers and payers navigate the federal and state laws that govern sharing PHI. The tool is extremely popular with hundreds of downloads by providers and provider groups.
