The facility no longer meets modern safety, environmental, or operational standards and presents significant health and safety risks to officers and partner agencies. This project will create a safe, code-compliant, and fully functional regional law enforcement training facility that protects officer health, improves training effectiveness, and strengthens inter-agency partnerships as the Westland range serves multiple agencies including, Wayne Police Department, Canton Police Department, Garden City Police Department, Fire Department Arson Investigators, and 18th District Court Officers. The breakdown of this project is as follows: Target
